while respecting environmental criteria.



1,8 kg VS 24,9 kg

In 1998, just 1.8 kg per inhabitant was collected whereas today we have reached about 23,7 kg per person.



Plastic takes over 400 years to degrade, so most of the plastic ever produced still exists in some form.

Only 5% has been incinerated.



63% of the plastic packaging is recycled while 27% is sent to waste-to-energy plants.



It takes about 2 kg of oil to obtain 1 kg of PET plastic.



Every year, about 11 million tons of plastic end up in the sea, contributing to 80% of the total pollution of the seas and oceans.



bottles, over 800,000 tonnes of oil are needed, and over 2 millions tonnes of CO2 are released into the atmosphere.



After steel and concrete, plastic is the third most widespread human material on Earth.
